questions you will have the information required already noted down.

MINIMUM EXPECTATIONS

Your task:

At the end of the 41 lessons you should have a comprehensive knowledge of the text.

Spend **some time** creating a **portfolio** of your answered questions and any notes you have taken. Remember although it is Jekyl and Hyde based many of the skills needed to answer the checkpoint questions can be transferred across Language Paper 1 and both Literature Papers.

Your aim is to have a revision booklet that you can refer to in Year 11. Organise your portfolio into sections relating to the chapters/lessons. Each section to contain a summary of the lesson followed by the answers to your questions.
