Year 9: Digital Publishing

What is Digital Publishing?

Digital publishing involves the use of technology to create and share content online. Example products include e-Books, websites and online magazines.

Scenario

In lesson, you are creating a database of the countries that make up the G20 (the Group of 20). In this project, you need to create a one-page info graphic that introduces the G20; its history, the member countries and the function/purpose of the group.

Your Tasks (tick when complete):

1	<p>Preparation</p> <p>On one slide in PowerPoint, create a collage of images that you will need for your info graphic. These can be sourced from the Internet and must include a map of the G20 countries and their flags.</p>	
2	<p>Planning</p> <p>Produce a plan for the one page infographic you will create for this project. The plan must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Be digital (created on a computer).• Not include any drawings – use boxes to show where elements of the product will be located.• Show what colour scheme, font sizes, font colours and font styles you plan to use. The plan should <u>not</u> be coloured in.	
3	<p>Creation</p> <p>In any program you wish (Cloud, local or Office based), create your G20 infographic.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Meet the requirements of the scenario, read the above carefully.• Be just one page. Ideally, it should be landscape.	
4	<p>PDF & Submit</p> <p>You now need to export your infographic as a PDF (download as PDF or save as PDF). If you need help, you can ask your teacher. You need to email your task 2 plan and final infographic to your Computing teacher. The email MUST come from your RM Unify account, not a personal account.</p> <p>Your email address is: _____</p>
