















<p>Spectator Etiquette</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remaining quiet at appropriate moments (Serving in tennis, conversion in rugby) • Respecting the national anthems • Refraining from derogatory chants or booing • Applauding good play from the opposition 	<p>Negative effect of PEDs on Sport</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Harms the reputation of the sport • Spectators may question if they are viewing 'clean' sport • Mistrust of the results • Spectators become sceptical about the credibility of the sport • Loss of sponsorship and funding 	<p>What do WADA do to stop doping</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Testing • Process samples and carry out investigations • Whereabouts rule • Sanctions • Educational Strategies
