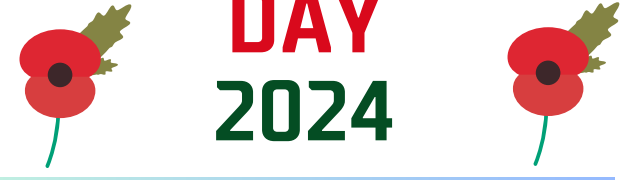

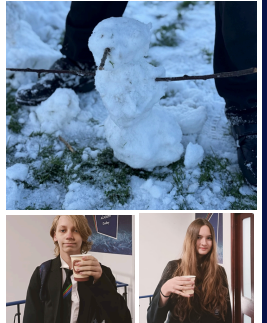

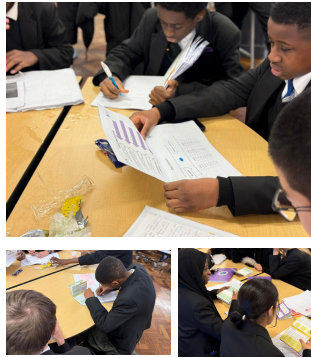
CHRISTMAS SHOP
